Requirements:

Accounting and Economics required (choose option 1 or 2; 6 – 12 hours):

___ Accounting 2301 OR Option 2*: Complete both ACC 2361 and ACC 2362

___ Economics 2301 OR Option 2*: Complete both ECO 2314 and ECO 2315

**If you intend to become a business major at some point you must complete option 2 to satisfy the lower-level business core requirement. ECO 2301 and ACC 2301 do not satisfy any business major requirements.*
